

Instructions to Parents with Children Having Dental Treatment Under Moderate Sedation at Smile Garden Dentistry

- Your child must not eat for 8 hours prior to their dental appointment.
 They may have clear fluids up to 2 hours prior to their appointment. Your child could become seriously ill if any food is given within the 8-hour timeframe. If this happens, the appointment will be cancelled for the safety of your child.
- 2. Your child must be physically well to undergo this procedure. If your child develops a **cold**, **cough**, **fever**, **respiratory infection or other illness** or is exposed to a contagious illness please call Wendy immediately at 613-384-0090.
- 3. Children may take Tylenol (Acetaminophen), Advil/Motrin (Ibuprofen) if needed up to 1 day prior to surgery. No aspirin or aspirin products should be given.
- 4. A parent or legal guardian **must** accompany the child to the dental clinic on the day of treatment.
- 5. Two adults **must** accompany the child on the ride home.

Our sedation time is limited and we have many children who require this service. If it is necessary to cancel your child's scheduled appointment, please notify us as soon as possible to enable other child to receive treatment at this time.
